

Summer Reading List for Incoming 4th Grade Students

Incoming 4th graders will be required to read a minimum of three books during the summer.

They must read, *Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing*, by Judy Blume. The students can buy the book or check it out from the local library. The students will be tested on their comprehension of the book when they return to school.

AND...

The students must also read two books from the Recommended Reading List below. They must write a three-paragraph book report on each book they read. This will be due the first day of school. This will count as their first two reading grades of the first semester.
